

Important Update on IIBEC's 2026 Proposed Bylaws Amendments

Dear IIBEC Members,

On behalf of the IIBEC Board of Directors, thank you for taking up the call we made during the Annual Meeting of the Members to engage thoughtfully, share your perspectives, and take the time to be part of this conversation. That level of participation matters, and it's what strengthens IIBEC as an organization.

It's clear from the feedback received that Ballot Question #2, related to expanding voting eligibility to credentialed members, prompted a wide range of views. While the Task Force and Board put careful thought into this recommendation, we also recognize that the level of feedback signals the need for continued dialogue with the membership. As a result, the Board has made the decision to table this question for the time being to allow that conversation to continue before any future vote is brought forward.

The Board will, however, proceed with Ballot Question #1. This question focuses on legal and administrative bylaw updates and strengthens the requirements for service on the IIBEC Board. These proposed changes are intended to improve clarity, support sound governance, and reinforce strong leadership standards for the organization.

These updates have been reflected on the 2026 Proposed Amendments webpage and on the ballot which you will receive on April 22, 2026.

We appreciate the professionalism, passion, and commitment members have brought to this process. Your feedback is valued and is helping shape a thoughtful path forward for IIBEC.
